The meeting was opened with the reading of the Twelve Traditions and the Twelve Concept. We had 9 of 15 areas present. The new area (South Central Ga) doesn't have PR committee at the present time.

Coastal Area brought to the floor a concern that they attempted to handle with a facility running commercials using NA's name to bring people to their facility. They didn't have any success with explaining to the facility that they couldn't use NA's name. Experience was shared and a solution was decided on to contact Stephen from World Services to handle the situation.

At the June RSC meeting I was asked to compose a draft to describe the blanket toll free number for

all of the PR chairs to be able to be uniform when taking the information back to their areas. I presented this to the committee and they approved. We also discussed that we should present it to the Regional floor so RCMs can also be informed at their area meetings. This also would give the areas this information that didn't have PR chairs present but did have RCMs present. The purpose is for feed back from the groups if this is wanted.

There are two upcoming events that the Regional PR committee will be present at. The first will be GARR Recovery Fair on Sept. 24th. The second is the Atlanta Pride festival on Oct. 9th and 10th. We had a workshop that included a PR inventory. Our goal is to set PR Regional goals and to prioritize our activities. One topic that has been brought up is more training of Area PR chairs. The meeting was closed with the we version of the serenity prayer.
